## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **What candidates does Ballotpedia create profiles for?**

Ballotpedia covers all candidates for federal office, state legislative candidates, [state executive candidates](#), candidates for mayor and city council in the 100 largest cities by population, and [school board candidates](#) in the 200 largest school districts by student enrollment, the school districts that overlap the 100 largest cities by population, and the 50 largest school districts in Wisconsin.

### **When will my information be uploaded?**

Biographies and photos are uploaded in the order in which they are received. The timeframe from when you submit your information until it is reflected on Ballotpedia may vary over the course of the year. We have a small but dedicated staff that is working hard to create this content!

### **How do I get my candidate election label on Twitter?**

Labels appear on the campaign Twitter accounts of candidates running for state Governor, or for the U.S. Senate or U.S. House of Representatives, during the 2018 U.S. midterm general election. Candidates looking to get their Twitter handle verified should take the following steps: first, please send your handle to

editor@ballotpedia.org. Once candidates make it through their primary election, Ballotpedia will pass that information to Twitter. Twitter will be reviewing candidates for both verification and labeling on a rolling basis, after each primary election passes. Both processes (the blue badge and label) will be done in tandem.
